Rationale: The Lectionary "Introduction" (chap. 5, par. 98; 2nd edition, 1981) briefly explains the rationale for reading choices for Weekdays of Lent:

- "The readings from the Gospels and the Old Testament were selected because they are related to each other. They treat various themes of the Lenten catechesis that are suited to the spiritual significance of this season.
- Beginning with Monday of the Fourth Week of Lent, there is a semicontinuous reading of the Gospel of John, made up of texts that correspond
 more closely to the themes proper to Lent.
- Because the readings about the Samaritan woman, the man born blind, and the raising of Lazarus are now assigned to Sundays, but only for Year A (in Year B and Year C they are optional), provision has been made for their use on weekdays.
- Thus at the beginning of the Third, Fourth, and Fifth Weeks of Lent **optional Masses** with these texts for the Gospel have been inserted and may be used in place of the readings of the day on any weekday of the respective week.
- In the first days of Holy Week the readings are about the mystery of Christ's passion.
- For the Chrism Mass the readings bring out both Christ's Messianic mission and its continuation in the Church by means of the sacraments."

An Overview of the First Readings for Weekday Masses

The First Readings prescribed for Weekday Masses in the special liturgical seasons are the same each year.

- Season of Advent: selections from various OT books, esp. the prophet Isaiah;
- Christmas Season: continuous reading of entire First Letter of John (Dec. 27 to Jan. 12; interrupted only for Feast of Mary, Mother of God [Jan. 1], and Feast of Epiphany of the Lord)
- Season of Lent: selections from a wide variety of OT books, with no connected pattern;
- Easter Season: semi-continuous readings from the Acts of the Apostles

The First Readings prescribed for Weekday Masses in **Ordinary Time** *follow a two-year cycle*, with semi-continuous readings from various books of the OT and NT. The following chart lists the biblical books and chapters from which the readings are taken for the weeks indicated. Note that most readings include only a small number of verses, not the entire chapters listed; verse numbers are not specified in this chart to provide a simpler overview of the overall patterns.

Notes:

- 1) The chart above provides additional information through some special features:
 - light blue backgrounds indicate readings from the Old Testament/Hebrew Bible;
 - light green backgrounds indicate readings from the Deuterocanonical Books of the OT;
 - plain white backgrounds indicate readings from the New Testament books and epistles;
 - chapter numbers in **bold** indicate that all or most (at least 80%) of the chapter is included in the readings;
 - chapter numbers not bolded indicate that only part of the chapter is included (sometimes only a few verses).
- 2) This chart *summarizes* the readings prescribed for each week, rather than listing the six weekday Masses separately (in some weeks, fewer chapters are listed since several Masses that week may have short selections from the same biblical chapter; in other weeks, more than six chapters are listed because some Mass readings may include verses from two or more biblical chapters).
- 3) The introductory sections of all published Weekday Lectionaries include a similar table showing the "Order of the First Reading for Weekdays in Ordinary Time." That table can give the false impression, however, that the weekday readings include the entire biblical books listed for the two-year cycle. In contrast, the chart above more clearly shows how many chapters are not included in the prescribed readings for weekday Masses. (For example, selections from only 14 of the 40 chapters of Exodus, from only 7 of the 25 chapters of 2 Kings, and from only 2 of the 15 chapters of 2 Maccabees are included; in contrast, almost the entire Letter to the Ephesians and the entire Epistle of James are included).
